

There will be no GATE Pull-out services the week of March 22<sup>nd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>.  
Pull-out Services will resume on March 29<sup>th</sup>.

Each school site will be either in-person, remote, or a combination of both. Your child's pull-out teacher will let you know the specific modality for learning before Spring Break.

### In-Person Classes

- In-person pull-out services will occur at sites that have 6 or more in-person pull-out students.
- Students will continue to attend GATE class in multigrade groups.
- Students will be utilizing individual supplies for GATE class.
- Students will participate in interactive in-person lessons.
- Teachers will have hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies for use in the classroom.
- Students will wear their face coverings to GATE class.

### Remote Classes

- Sites that have fewer than 6 in-person students will be taught remotely and will join the remote students on Zoom.
- Remote students will continue to receive 90 minutes of instruction designed for the remote (Zoom) learning modality.
