USDA announced yesterday that is has extended the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) waiver through December 31, 2020 (or until federal funding runs out). What this means is effective starting 9/2 under SFSP. Meals are free to all children 18 and under, which applies to our meals on site and Grab-n-Go meals on our bus routes.

This is great news to make meals more accessible to all in our community during these challenging times. This waiver extension also eliminates a tremendous administrative burden on the accountability aspect of serving and claiming meals in various serving models to support remote and on site learning.

Hudlow as well as all of TUSD is using Clever and all the Apps that are on this platform for our daily educational lessons and access to all our resources. This framework provides teachers with an abundance of resources, assessments, and the necessary lessons that provide students the opportunity to be successful. I am extremely dedicated to support the teachers and students with this new program. Our focus is to move forward and provide students with rigorous, high levels of academic instruction in a safe student-centered environment. This years goals include increasing the number of students mastering standards in reading, writing, and math.

School starts at 7:45 AM, it is imperative that children attend zoom meetings daily. They are also held accountable for their Asynchronous learning. Teachers are assigning them homework and other class work to do on their own. Please make an attempt to have your child log in daily, on time, stay on line for the entire live session as well as have them log into their other applications and their assignments that need to be turned in. This is week four, your children have been assessed or are currently being assessed in multiple content areas.

Please make sure that your children are in a quite place, ready to learn, and have all their books ready and accessible in order to be successful. They might also benefit from a snack and water.
