## Cell Phone Policy:

**\*We do not allow students to use cell phones, iPods or video games during instructional or lunch hours at school. All cell phones and electronic devices must be turned off and remain out of sight within the instructional hours of our school. They may be placed in the students backpack or turned into the office for safe keeping and they must remain there during the entire school day.** If a student is seen using one of these devices or if it goes off during class, the item will be sent to the office to be locked in a secure location.
